## **SA Exposure Locations**

## **Vaccination Eligibility Updates**

All individuals aged 12+ years are now eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccinations.

Phase 1 populations (such as aged care and disability care residents/workers, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 12+ years, health care workers and individuals with underlying conditions) should still be prioritised.

### **Moderna Vaccine**

The Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is now available at participating pharmacies to anyone aged 12+ years. To find a participating pharmacy, visit the Department of Health's website.

## **Additional Vaccination Clinics**

Additional COVID-19 vaccination clinics are now available for individuals aged 16+ years.

# **Vaccine Hesitancy Webinar**

#### **Vaccination Milestone**

South Australia has reached a major milestone with 1.5 million COVID-19 vaccine doses administered. More than 610,000 South Australians are now fully vaccinated. Find more information or book an appointment on the SA Health website.

COVID-19 Vaccine Suitability Assessment Services for Individuals with a Disability GPs and other medical practitioners (OMPs) who conduct COVID-19 vaccine suitability assessment services in a residential disability facility setting or a patient's place of residence can claim a <u>flag-fall fee</u> through the Medicare Benefits Schedule. GPs and OMPs may also claim in-depth clinical assessments for these individuals.

Please note the claiming GP or OMP is responsible for satisfying all requirements when claiming Medicare Benefits Schedule items.

## **Incentive Payment for Specific Vaccination Services**

Primary care providers (general practices, Commonwealth Vaccination Clinics and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community Controlled Health Services) can claim an additional incentive payment if they undertake in-reach COVID-19 vaccination services for residential aged care and disability care workers.

# **Proof of Vaccination**

You can print a patients' immunisation history statement or COVID-19 digital certificates from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) website.

## Free Interpreting Service for COVID-19 Vaccinations

The Free Interpreting Service has been extended to include non-Medicare Patients and onsite interpreters for weekend vaccinations. Onsite interpreter bookings can be made via <a href="mailto:tis.freeinterpreting@homeaffairs.gov.au">tis.freeinterpreting@homeaffairs.gov.au</a>. Please note telephone interpreting services remain available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Medical practices can use their TIS client code to request interpreters. For those medical practices not already registered, they can do so via the TIS website.

# **Syringe Size Change for Pfizer Doses**

For the next short period, Pfizer orders will receive a 5mL syringe rather than 3mL. Please only draw-up the appropriate amount of saline to reconstitute your Pfizer doses.

# **AIR Reporting**

Services Australia has identified AIR records where the COVID-19 vaccine batch number has been entered incorrectly or left blank. Please ensure all details are entered correctly.
