### **Influenza Vaccine Orders**

Experts predict a rebound season of influenza is highly probable once lockdowns ease and borders re-open and are warning that Australia will experience issues with vaccine supply not meeting demand when it comes to influenza vaccination in 2022. The Immunisation Coalition is urging healthcare providers, including GPs, pharmacists, and relevant clinics, to carefully consider and place their orders for influenza vaccination before 19 November 2021.

Chairman of the Immunisation Coalition, Dr Rod Pearce adds: “What is important now, is that we avoid a vaccine shortage next year because providers have reduced their vaccine orders for 2022, based on reduced cases and vaccine uptake this year.”
